<u>Reminders</u>

Thesis is the topic and date plus an opinion about its impact or effects.

Three to five concrete details are what you are researching for each main idea, enough to fully explain the main idea.

- 1. Know which resource gave which CD DIRECTLY on the Day Two Handout.
- 2. Note each CD in a notecard in Noodle Tools within its source.

Consult and cite at least three different sources in Noodle Tools. Don't cite a source if you generate no notecards containing details supporting a main idea.

Anything from below is your responsibility to finish before Monday.

I should have:

- 1. Day 2 Handout with a thesis (Topic, Date, Opinion)
- 2. Day 2 Handout with 3-5 concrete details for each of the three main ideas
- 3. Noodle Tools
 - a. Project Title of "Name and Topic with Date, day and month"
 - b. Shared with Thompson 2017 + your hour
 - c. All sources (3 Minimum) cited in Noodle Tools
 - d. Note cards
 - i. Should be included with the source from which the note was taken
 - ii. Each notecard should be titled for which "Main Idea" it references (ie. Impact A)
 - iii. Each should contain a concrete detail from the Day 2 Handout (ie. If you have 11 CDs, 11 notecards will exist in Noodle tools)
- 4. Must FIND at least one print source. (EBSCO is preferred watch for page #s)
 - a. This is the primary focus in order to understand citing page numbers.
 - b. Find at least one detail to include in any main idea.
 - c. Use the Perma Link for the URL in noodle tools.
- 5. Print a draft of your "Works Cited" and take with you to use at the first of class Monday. In Noodle Tools above your sources, click "Print/Export" and then select "Print/Export to Word".
